People and animals can't move between bubbles otherwise both bubbles will pop – and the virus could get inside.

Keep in touch using video calls, or even a simple phone call.

We need people to stay at home unless they have a reason to be out – like accessing essential services.

Veterinarians are essential services, but even we have to act differently during alert level 4 - if you need us, make sure you call us first!



Stay in your bubble. Save lives.

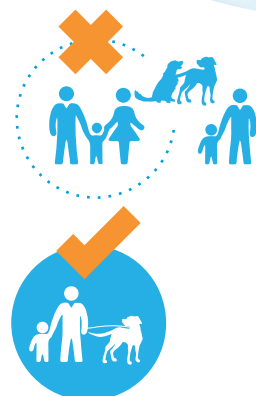

If you're an essential service worker, you will have to move in and out of your household bubble. To reduce the risk to others in your bubble, try to keep your distance from others at work, and at home.

If anyone in your bubble gets sick, they need to self-isolate and be in a bubble within a bubble.
