

## Is it an emergency?

# Find out if your pet really needs that after-hours visit

If your pet is...

*Bleeding from the nose, mouth or rectum*

*Coughing up blood, or passing blood when they pee*

*Choking, struggling to breathe, or coughing and gagging continuously*

*Having seizures or staggering*

*Suffering from heat stress or heatstroke*

*Unable to move their legs*

*Bleeding heavily (or for longer than five minutes)*

*Unconscious*



Or they have:

*Fractured bones*

*Injuries to their eye(s)*

*Eaten something poisonous*

**These are all signs of serious injuries or health conditions.**

**Call us immediately!**

Over the last 24 hours, has your pet:

*Struggled to urinate or poop*

*Showed obvious signs of pain or extreme anxiety*

*Refused to drink for 24 hours or more*

*Vomited or had diarrhoea more than twice*
