Find out if your pet really needs that after-hours visit

If your pet is...

Bleeding from the nose, mouth or rectum

Coughing up blood, or passing blood when they pee

Choking, struggling to breathe, or coughing and gagging continuously

Having seizures or staggering

Suffering from heat stress or heatstroke

Unable to move their legs

Bleeding heavily (or for longer than five minutes)

Unconscious



Fractured bones

Injuries to their eye(s)

Eaten something poisonous

These are all signs of serious injuries or health conditions.

Over the last 24 hours, has your pet:

Struggled to urinate or poop

Showed obvious signs of pain or extreme anxiety

Refused to drink for 24 hours or more

Vomited or had diarrhoea more than twice
